- Load bus from Edmonton Inn (11834 Kingsway Ave) — **NORTHSIDE** parking Lot area main lobby area. Free parking is available at your own risk. The Edmonton Inn suggests that you register your vehicle by completing their Long-Term Parking registration/waiver to help prevent the risk of being towed. A copy of this waiver will be provided upon check-in with our Tour Director or available at the front desk of the hotel. Please note the departure location may change to somewhere on NAIT campus and if so we will let everyone know.

You will be required to check-in with the MagicBus Tour Director inside the entrance area prior to being able to get on the bus or load your gear. You are welcome to bring your gear and set it near the bus, so that it's ready to be loaded as soon as you're done checking in!

ONLY after the Tour Director has confirmed your Waiver is complete you will be permitted to load your gear, then board the bus. If you have not completed your Waiver prior to the trip then you will be asked to do so now by signing a printed waiver or online from the link below.

Seats are chosen on a first come basis. Guests are encouraged to avoid boarding and exiting the bus multiple times to keep the bus aisle clear. Please load your gear in the bins prior to boarding the bus and choosing a seat.

NO BYOB allowed in the bus, any alcohol you may be bringing for the weekend must be stored in the bins below with luggage and ski gear. Thanks in advance for your cooperation.

- Depart for Jasper. The Tour Director's will be serving everyone with 2-3 adult beverages on-route along with serving Italian Bakery catering (meats/cheeses/buns).

A toilet is available on the bus when necessary and can be used at your own risk. There will be a self-sanitization spray or hand sanitizer available in the toilet.

- Approx. arrival in Jasper at the *Tonquin Inn (100 Juniper Ave)*. One person from each room may need to provide a credit card at the Front Desk (for incidentals and such). Please stay on the bus until the Tour Directors obtain everyone's room keys. Everyone will depart the bus from front to back once the Tour Directors have obtained everyone's room keys. Please wait on the bus until the Tour Director advises you to get off. You can leave your skis and boards under the bus (at your own risk) but take your overnight bag and boots to your room. If for some reason you will be finding your own way to the hill tomorrow please let the Tour Director know and they will give you your lift cards. Also make sure you take your ski/board equipment off the bus and store it in the hotel.

**8:00 am** - Bus will be available for boarding for those going to the ski hill.

**8:30 am** - Bus will depart for Marmot Basin Ski Resort. Tour Director's will distribute lift

cards en-route.

<u>Please note:</u> \*Marmot Basin is using RFID lift cards replacing paper lift tickets. These RFID cards cannot be fastened to clothing and should be secured in a pocket on the left side of your ski jacket (outside sleeve pocket is best). Make sure your phone or wallet is not in the same pocket as your RFID lift card. We suggest that everyone take a picture of the front and back of their RFID card if possible. Lift cards are non-refundable but if there are any issues or problems with your RFID card please visit Group Sales. NO guarantee of refunds..

- \*No outdoor food is permitted inside their facilities. Table seating is reserved for paying customers. Other than in Jim's Den Chalet at mid-mountain.
- \* You may keep items on the bus but please note you will not have access to it during the day. All items left on the bus are at your own risk.
- \* The lockers (credit card needed) and free cubby facilities may be limited and there is a possibility they will not be available. Consider wearing a backpack if you need anything throughout the day. Boot and ski/board bags can be left on the bus, but you will not have access to the bus until 4pm.

**4:00 pm** - Bus available for boarding at Marmot Basin.

**4:30 pm** - Bus departs for hotel.
