

U of A International Students Marmot Basin Ski Trip Itinerary January 20th, 2024

Preparation for your trip:

Please make sure you have the proper winter gear. Wind chill can change the temperature dramatically up at the Ski Resort. To ensure that you enjoy your day please wear/bring:

- A breathable base layer to remove perspiration.
- A mid-layer to keep you warm. It could be a fleece, or a light insulated jacket worn over your thermal base layer.
- An outer layer (Jacket) to protect you from the elements.
- Neck warmer, even a thin one or scarf, will give you good additional protection against the cold and the wind.
- Snow pants with thermal underwear underneath.
- Gloves that are waterproof and not too tight if you get cold hands.
- Ski socks made from synthetic fibers or from merino wool.
- Goggles offer better protection than sun glasses.
- Sun Protection...Apply sunscreen. Even those individuals that tan will be exposed to extreme UV levels due to the high elevation, on sunny and cloudy days, so please apply sunscreen regularly throughout the day.
- Dehydration also occurs more quickly at this altitude, so be sure to drink plenty of water during your ski day.
- Ride carefully and stay within the resort boundaries.

4:00 am Load bus from 142 Telus Centre (87 Ave and 111 Street, Edmonton, AB).

Please check-in with the MagicBus Directors upon arrival. Waivers will need to be signed either in the morning on the day of departure or online prior to your trip departure from the link below:

Please note: This is non-drinking trip and NO alcohol will be allowed on-board.

- 4:30 am Depart for Marmot Basin. A quick stop may be made in Hinton at the A & W.
- 8:00amish -Quick stop will be made at the Park Gates.
- 9:00 am Approx. arrival at Marmot Basin Ski Resort. Please stay on the bus until the Tour Directors obtain everyone's lift cards. As the Tour Director is handing out the lift cards they will let everyone know where to go to obtain rentals and meeting spot for lessons.

- Marmot Basin uses RFID lift cards replacing paper lift tickets. These RFID cards cannot be fastened to clothing and should be secured in a pocket on the left side of your ski jacket outside sleeve pocket is best). Make sure your phone or wallet is not in the same pocket as your RFID lift card. We suggest that you take a picture of your RFID card if possible. Lift cards are non-refundable but if any issues or problems with your RFID card please visit Group Sales. NO guarantee of refunds.
- No outdoor food is permitted inside Marmot's facilities. Table seating is reserved for paying customers. Other than in Jim's Den Chalet at mid-mountain.
- You may keep items on the bus but please note you will not have access to it during the day.
- All items left on the bus are at your own risk so do not leave valuables on the bus. Lockers inside for \$7-\$14 per day (credit card needed). There are also free cubbies that may be available, at your own risk, on the deck near the rentals and upstairs near the bar.
- The space upstairs near the coffee shop can be used to get ready between 8am 10:30am as long as no personal belongings are left in the space and its left clean.
- **10:00 am** One-hour lessons will start at the Magic Carpet area.
- 11am-4pm Free time to ski/board.
- 4:00 pm Bus will be available for loading at the ski hill and the Tour Director will distribute bottled of water to everyone.
- 4:30 pm Bus will depart ski hill for Edmonton.
- 5:30 pm Quick stop again in Hinton at A & W.
- 9:00 pm Approx. arrival in Edmonton
