DAY 1: FRIDAY, MARCH 13, 2026

4:30 pm Check-in begins for the Live it Up Weekender to Jasper at the Edmonton Inn **North Side** parking lot at 11834 Kingsway Avenue. You will be required to check-in with the Live it Up Tour Director inside the entrance area prior to being able to get on the motorcoach or load your gear. You are welcome to bring your gear and set it near the motorcoach, so that it's ready to be loaded as soon as you're done checking in! Free parking is available at your own risk; the Tour Directors have vehicle registration forms, and it's recommended to complete this

ONLY after the Tour Director has confirmed your Waiver and Terms is complete will you be permitted to load your gear, then board the motorcoach. If you have not completed your Waiver and Terms prior to the trip then you will be asked to do so now. Seats are chosen on a first come basis. Guests are encouraged to avoid boarding and exiting the motorcoach multiple times to keep the motorcoach aisle clear. Please load your gear in the bins prior to boarding the motorcoach and choosing a seat.

4:55 pm Boarding ends. Get seated, we're ready to roll.

5:00 pm Depart for Jasper. Relax after your long week and enjoy the ride. Socialize with your cohort(s), watch movies, work or just do what you need to do. There will be Italian Bakery catering available on-board (meats/cheeses/buns) as well as 2-3 adult beverages. This will be handed out by the Tour Directors. No BYOB.

A toilet is available on the motorcoach when necessary and can be used at your own risk. There will be a self-sanitization spray or hand sanitizer available in the toilet.

7:50 pm Quick break in Hinton for supper at the A&W Restaurant (not included, 333 Gregg Ave).

9:00 pm Approx. arrival in Jasper at the *Jasper Inn* (98 Geikie Street). Please remain onboard, while the Tour Director obtains everyone's room keys. Everyone will depart the motorcoach from front to back once the Tour Directors have obtained everyone's room keys. Please wait on the motorcoach until the Tour Director advises you to get off. You can leave your skis and boards under the motorcoach (at your own risk) but take your overnight bag and boots to your room. If for some reason you will be finding your own way to the hill tomorrow please let the Tour Director know and they will give you your lift cards. One person from each room may have to provide a credit card or cash deposit at the front desk for any incidentals and such.

Note: Live it Up reserves the right to pass along any charges levied by suppliers with respect to hotel damages or unpaid incidental charges. To be enjoyable for all guests, please keep in mind that the hotel has a strict 11:00pm quiet hour.

DAY 2: SATURDAY, MARCH 14, 2026

8:00 am Boarding begins for those going to Marmot Basin. The Tour Director will be handing out your lift cards as you board the motorcoach.

You will be issued single-day RFID lift tickets for all the days you have purchased. If you are skiing multiple days, ensure the lift tickets are separated when scanning at the lift to avoid scanning both on the same day. RFID cards cannot be fastened to clothing and DO NOT place near phone or wallet. You are encouraged to take a photo of the front and back of the RFID card but please be aware that lost or stolen lift tickets may only be replaced at the sole discretion of Marmot Basin. Make sure to place your card inside the LEFT sleeve pocket of your jacket. If you have any issues with your lift card please visit Group Sales and show your receipt of payment for your MagicBus Tours Weekender. NO guarantee of refunds.

8:15 am Depart for Marmot Basin.

8:45 am Arrival at the Marmot Basin!
The lockers (credit card needed) and free cubby facilities may be limited and there is a possibility they will not be available. Consider wearing a backpack if you need anything throughout the day. Boot and ski/board bags can be left on the motorcoach, but you will not have access to the motorcoach until 4pm.
If you have signed up for the **Discover Downhill Package** you will be directed to go to the Rentals area to receive your rentals. Then proceed to meet up at the Magic Carpet area for your lesson and to obtain your lift ticket.

1:30 pm or 9:30 am If you have signed up for the **Maligne Valley/Pleckaitis Icewalk Tour** with SunDog Tours you will be picked up at your hotel. This tour is 3 hours.

This is a scenic adventure that takes you through some of the most breathtaking landscapes in Jasper National Park. This tour covers three iconic spots each offering unique views and natural beauty

1. **Maligne Valley Lookout:**

- The tour begins with a visit to the **Maligne Valley Lookout**, an elevated spot providing sweeping views of the surrounding mountain ranges, valleys, and forests. It's an ideal vantage point to take in the grandeur of Jasper National Park. The lookout offers opportunities for photography and awe-inspiring vistas of the park's natural beauty.

2. **Pleckaitis Canyon:**

- The next stop is **Pleckaitis Canyon**, a hidden secret in Jasper, known for its dramatic landscape. The canyon is carved by a glacial river and features unique rock formations, narrow passages, and waterfalls. 3. **Medicine Lake:**

- The final stop on the tour is **Medicine Lake**, one of Jasper's most famous and mysterious locations. This is located in the heart of Maligne Valley. What makes Medicine Lake unique is its seasonal draining that sees the lake freezing over in the winter. The lake is significant to Indigenous people, and its name reflects the area's spiritual and cultural importance.

Throughout the tour, guests will enjoy the spectacular scenery of the **Maligne Valley**, passing through new burn, lush forests, and old burn. This tour offers a mix of easy walks, sightseeing, and photography opportunities, making it an excellent way to experience the natural wonders of Maligne Valley.

To ensure that you enjoy the tour, please wear/bring:

- Thermals/base layers/long johns.
- Snow pants are recommended for this tour and are mandatory if it is below -16C (3F)
- A warm sweater.
- A warm jacket.
- A hat and mitts.
- A neck warmer or scarf.

They will provide: Thermal Boots (shoe size will be required), Cleats, Helmet, Poles and hand warmers if requested.
